



## **Admissions Policies and Procedures High School**

Students and their parents arrange a visit to the school by calling the admissions office during school hours (8:00 am - 3:30 pm).

Students and their parents must submit the enclosed application forms with a \$50.00 non-refundable application fee and previous school records. To enable us to connect names with faces, please enclose a recent photograph of the student.

We will confirm receipt of your application and the Admissions Director will arrange an interview with two high school faculty members, parents and student. On the day of the interview, the student should plan to spend the day. Parents should plan to join us at 2:10 pm for the interview.

We will notify you of our decision by mail within two weeks of the interview. To enroll, parents must complete the enrollment contract and submit it along with the \$100 non-refundable tuition deposit within two weeks of receipt. This will ensure the student's place in the school.

Families may apply for tuition scholarships and applications should be submitted with the completed application. If parents are unsure whether they qualify for scholarships, they may talk to a member of the Tuition Scholarship Committee.

All new enrollments are conditional for 10 weeks in order to allow time for the faculty to observe the student and to determine whether our school can meet the student's needs.

Parents should be in agreement with and supportive of the school's philosophy and understand the basic tenets of Waldorf education. Please read the high school portion of our school brochure and the enclosed article. For the student to gain the most benefit from his or her education, it is important that parents support the faculty's work at school.

Our school is designed to meet the needs of students who have a moderate range of developmental needs. For further information, request the Policy in Working With Learning Needs document. We are happy to meet with families to assess whether we are able to meet the needs of any student with special requirements.
