

Thank you for your interest in the Lake Champlain Waldorf High School. Our high school has a vibrant international exchange program with French and German speaking students as well as students from English speaking countries.

LCWHS is quite small, with an average of 65 students in grades 9 – 12. The school is located just outside of Burlington, Vermont, a small city rich in cultural activities, shopping and outdoor recreation. Burlington is located six hours by car north of New York City, four hours from Boston and just under two hours south of Montreal, Canada. Vermont is a beautiful state, renowned for its natural beauty of lakes, forests, mountains and farms.

We offer a rich and full Waldorf curriculum in a warm and friendly environment. Foreign exchange and visiting students are supported in their academic and home life by their advisor, who works hard to insure a positive experience. Students whose written skills are weak are expected to work with an English language tutor once or twice a week, for which there is a fee.

If you are interested in applying to our exchange program, please email me a letter of introduction describing your family, where you live and your interests and hobbies. Be sure to include a photo of yourself. I will offer your letter to LCWHS students searching for an exchange partner. If one of our students is interested in pursuing an exchange with you, I will let you know and advise you of the next steps in the application process.
